The appointee will mainly provide research and administrative support to projects on (1) early development and learning in infancy and toddlerhood, and (2) socio-cognitive and socio-emotional development in preschoolers. The appointee is responsible for reviewing the literature, developing research proposals and research materials, data coding and analysis, drafting research reports and manuscripts for dissemination of project findings. She/he will also coordinate activities facilitating disseminating of findings and research impact beyond academia, and perform other duties as assigned. The appointment will be for a period of 10 months.

Applicants should have a Master's degree, preferably in Psychology, Early Childhood Care and Education, or other related disciplines plus one year post Master's degree full-time working experience, or a Doctoral degree in the above mentioned disciplines. Applicants with post-qualification experiences working with young children will be an advantage. She/he should be highly motivated, responsible, and able to work independently. She/he should also have excellent analytical, decision-making, and interpersonal communication skills, high proficiency in both written and spoken Chinese (Cantonese) and English, and strong PC skills including MS Office, Photoshop, SPSS.
